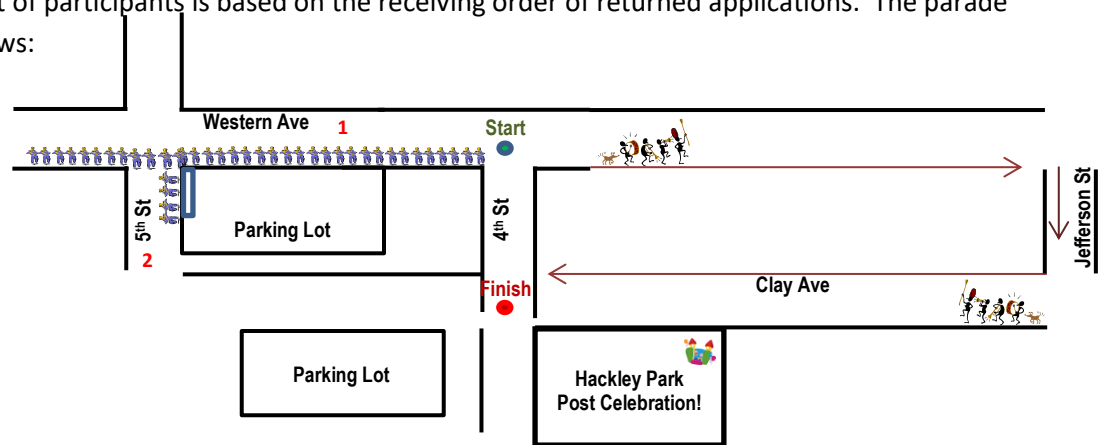


2023 Labor Day Parade and Celebration!

The line-ups will fill the parking lot located on the corner of 5th and Western Ave, along 5th Street (if needed) and down Western Ave. The placement of participants is based on the receiving order of returned applications. The parade starting order will be as follows:

1. Western Avenue
2. 5th Street line up



We plan to Step off at 11:00 a.m. from 4th Street and Western Avenue and march north along Western to Jefferson Street, where we will turn right onto Jefferson. We will then take another right onto Clay Avenue where we will continue to march until we reach 4th Street (so basically, one big rectangle). The post celebration will be held at Hackley Park (350 W. Webster Ave. Muskegon, MI 49443-9999)
